Papers are submitted via **e-mail**, in **WORD and PDF** format, following this template. The **pages** should not be numbered. The editor will arrange them in a consistent form for the final document.

Graphics and tables

Graphic representations such as charts, photos and line drawings should be in electronic form and pasted into the document directly. If it is possible, use JPEG format graphic files. By all means use color if it enhances the meaning of the figures. Text may be wrapped around figures if desired. Number your figures Figure 1, Figure 2, etc., with a short caption under each in **Times New Roman 10 pt, bold, italics** to distinguish it from the main text.

Tables should be labeled Table 1, Table 2, at the top of each table, with a short caption on the top of each table in **Times New Roman, 10 pt, bold, italics** to distinguish it from the main text.

This text is in Times New Roman, 12 pt, justified.

5. ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

List here, where applicable, funding sources for the work described and other contributors. This text is in Times New Roman, 11pt, justified.

6. REFERENCES

References will be written in Times New Roman, 10 pt, hanging indent of 1 cm.

Cite all references in the text by last names and year of publication Ex. (Bauwe et al., 2010); (Popescu and Ionescu, 2015); (Popescu, 2016). Grouped text citations should be arranged from the earliest to most recent year, alphabetized by name within the same year (Rouphael et al., 2015; Berruti et al., 2016; Cely et al., 2016). For entries in "REFERENCES," alphabetize by first author's last name and follow exactly the style guidelines provided below for capitalization, punctuation, and order of elements (according to the APA style guide).

The references are arranged alphabetically, by the last name of the fist author.

All references must be translated in English according to this example:

Theses: Author, B.C. (1974). Title of thesis. PhD thesis. City: University.

Online: Author A. (year of publication) Title of article. *Plant Physiol*, 59, 45–59. Retrieved March 20, 2010, from <http://www.plantphysiology.com>
